held at the Ball Room in the City of Annapolis on the
Tenth day of November Instant do hereby certify
and return that we did attend on the day of aforesaid and
did then and there appoint Edward Dubois
and Samuel Peaco Jurors of the election who
severally qualified as directed by law, we further certify
that we did then and there qualify as Judges of
said election as by law directed and did then and there
at the hour of 9 o'clock in the morning open the polls
for an election of two electors of President and Vice President
of the United States that we continued the polls open
until six o'clock in the evening of the same day when
they were closed the ballot box opened and the ballots
publicly counted when it appeared that John Steven
Tollman had one hundred and thirty six
votes Benjamin C. Howard had one hundred and
thirty five votes James Doyle had one hundred
and sixty three votes and William Stewart had one
hundred and sixty two votes.
