We further certify that we did there and there qualify as Judges of the said Election as required by Law, and did there and there at the hour of nine o'clock in the morning open the Polls for an Election of Four Electors for choosing President and Vice President for the first District that we continued the Polls open until Six o'clock in the Evening of the same day when they were closed, the ballot Box opened and the Ballots publicly counted when it appeared that Joseph Keul had one Hundred and thirty six votes General C. Casper had one hundred and thirty six votes William Bradley Taylor had one Hundred and thirty six votes William Price had one Hundred and thirty six votes and that William T. Smith, Robert Hanson and Washington D. Small had each one Hundred and nine votes.

Barber had one Hundred and thirty six votes, Richard G. Hutton had one Hundred and thirty three votes as Common Council men.
