then and there, before a justice of the peace of Anne  
Arundel County, qualify as judges of the election

until six o'clock in the evening of the same day

and Alexander Randall were elected Aldermen

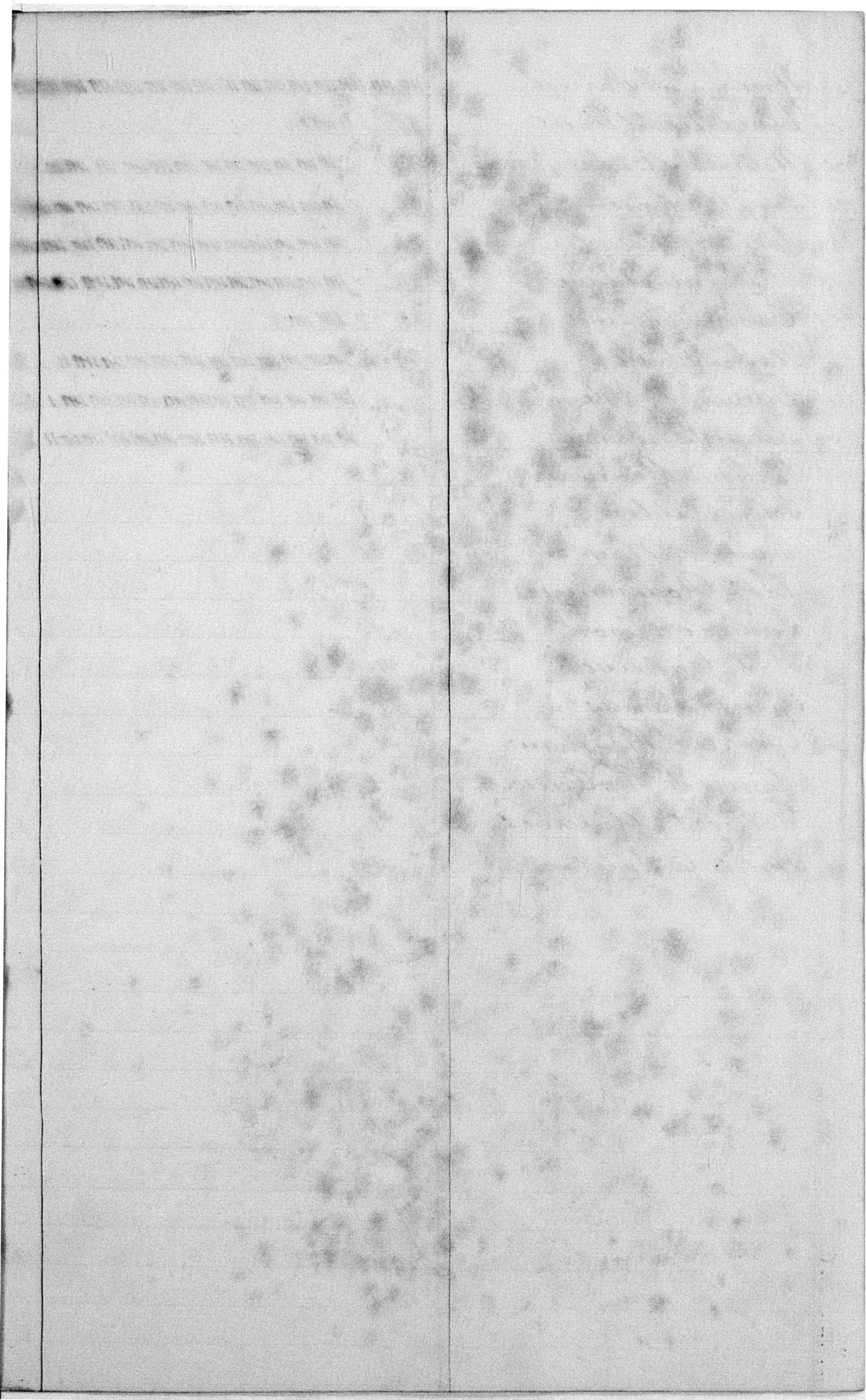
