General Washington resigns his commission as Commander-in-chief of the American Army, December 23, 1783.

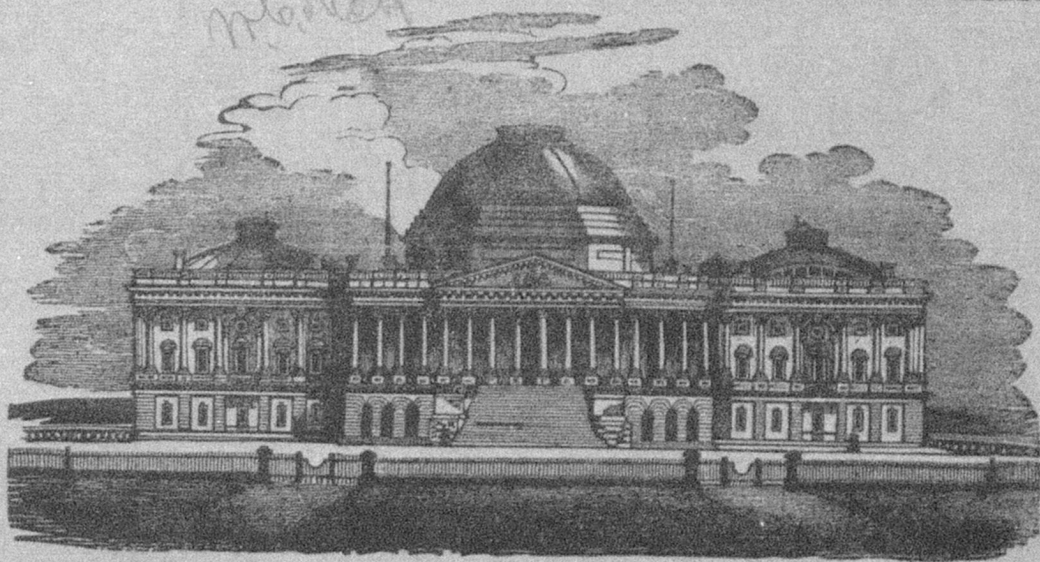
General Washington unanimously chosen President of the Convention for framing a new Constitution for the United States, convened at Philadelphia, May, 1787.

General Washington elected President of the United States, to serve for four years from March 4, 1789. Inaugurated at New York, April 30, 1789.

General Washington again elected President of the United States, to serve for four years from March 4, 1793.

General Washington a second time appointed Commander-in-chief of the American Army, July, 1793, in anticipation of a war with France.

General Washington died, December 14, 1799.

We the undersigned duly appointed by the Corporation of Annapolis Judges of Election do hereby certify and return that we did attend at the usual place of holding Elections in said City on the 6th day of April, 1857 and did then and there qualify as judges of Election as by Law directed, that we did also then and there appoint Charles Gassaway and Leonard C. Hurst Clerks of the said Election who also having qualified according to Law. We further certify that we did then and there open the polls for the Election of a Mayor, a Recorder and five Aldermen, to serve as the Corporation of the City of Annapolis for one year, at the hour of nine o'clock in the morning - that we continued the polls open until six o'clock of the evening of the same day, when they were closed, the ballot box opened, and the ballots publicly counted, when it appeared that for Mayor Richard Swann had five hundred and twenty seven votes and Abram Claude had two hundred & eleven votes. That for Recorder James Boyle had two hundred & twenty seven votes and Nicholas Brewer Esq. had two hundred & twelve votes. That for Aldermen Benjamin Smith-Cum had two hundred & twenty six votes Daniel Cawek had two hundred & thirty five votes, Thomas A. Mitchell had two hundred

and twenty one votes Richard H Holland
had two hundred & twenty six votes, John R
Magruder had two hundred and ten votes.
Solomon Phillip had two hundred & fourteen
votes, Philip Clayton had two hundred
