George Washington, born, February 22, 1732.

Battle of White Plains, October 25, 1776.

Battle of Trenton, December 26, 1776.

Battle of Princeton, January 3, 1777.

Battle of Brandywine, September 11, 1777.

Battle of Germantown, October 4, 1777.

Surrender of Lord Cornwallis at Yorktown, Oct. 19, 1781.

Treaty of Peace between Great Britain and United States, signed Nov. 1782.



General Washington resigns his commission as Commander-in-chief of the American Army, December 23, 1783.

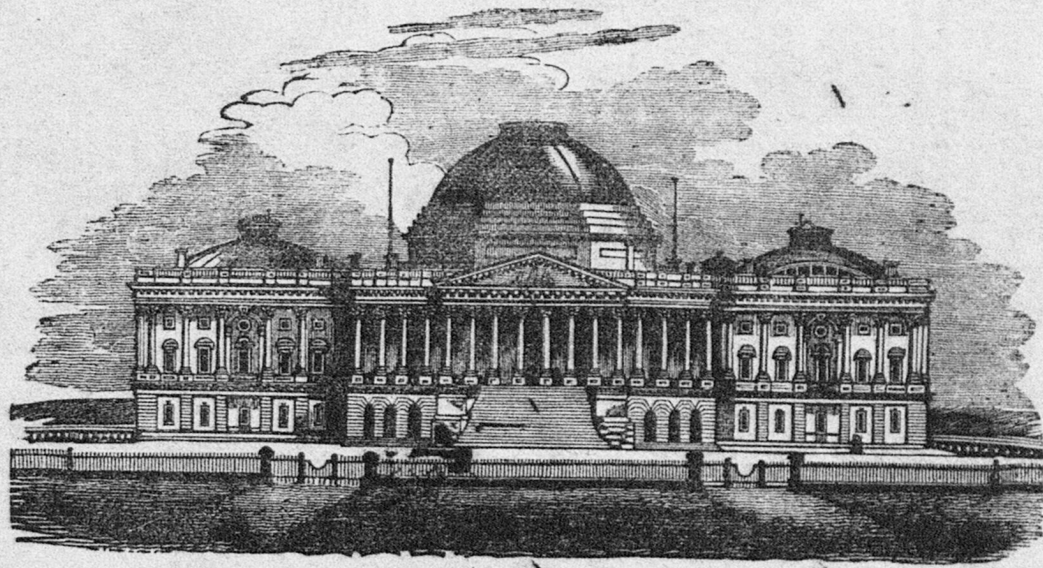
General Washington unanimously chosen President of the Convention for framing a new Constitution for the United States, convened at Philadelphia, May, 1787.

General Washington elected President of the United States, to serve for four years from March 4, 1789. Inaugurated at New York, April 30, 1789.

General Washington again elected President of the United States, to serve for four years from March 4, 1796.

General Washington a second time appointed Commander-in-chief of the American Army, July, 1799, in anticipation of a war with France.

General Washington died, December 14, 1799.

We the undersigned duly appointed by the Corporation of Annapolis Judges of Election do hereby certify and return that we did attend at the usual place of holding Elections in said city on Monday the 5th day of April 1858, and did then and there qualify as Judges of Election, as by law directed, that we did also then and there appoint Charles Gassaway and Richard H Green Clerks of the said Election who also having qualified according to Law, We further certify that we did then and there open the polls for the election of a Mayor, a Recorder and five Aldermen, to serve as the Corporation of the City of Annapolis for one year, at the hour of nine O'clock in the morning, that we continued the polls open until six O'clock of the Evening of the same day, when they were closed, the ballot box opened, and the ballots publicly counted when it appeared that for Mayor John Wotton had one hundred and eighty eight votes, and Joshua Brown had two hundred & twenty votes, that for Recorder Edwin Poyle had one hundred and eighty eight votes, and Thomas J Wilson had two hundred & seventeen votes, that for Aldermen John T Hammond had one hundred and eighty seven — votes John W Davis had one hundred & ninety nine votes David S Caldwell had one hundred and

ninety two — votes William Glover
had one hundred and ninety — votes
Weston M. Keohne had one hundred and
ninety — votes. George E. Franklin had
two hundred and twenty four votes. Thomas
Ireland had two hundred & twenty three votes
Philip Clayton had two hundred and
twenty votes James Munroe had two hundred
& nineteen votes and Solomon Phillips
had two hundred and eight teen votes
