May 4<sup>th</sup> 1809. U.S. Art'y. barracks

Sir

not having met with you in the last two days, I now think proper in this way to tell you that that part of your letter of the 2nd inst. which represents me to have written that I would regulate the report of the sick of my company independant of, & in contradiction to you, is false. Of the same character is your assertion that I have wished to bring you into contempt & disrepute with those under my command. The rest of your letter is too imperfext for a reply.

I will receive no further communication from you unless it is of a specific character desired by a gentleman.
