Beginning for the same at a point S 84° W. 4 ⁷/₁₀ prs from a stone marked "6" said to stand in the line of a tract of land called "Collinson's Choice" and running the following courses, viz N 73 ¹/₂° W. 78 prs, N 24 ¹/₂° E. 102 ⁸/₁₀ prs to a stone, N 87° E. 83 prs to Newport Branch, then up said Branch S 22° E 2 prs, S 69° E 9 prs, S 75° E 4 prs, S 36° E 14 prs, S 10° W. 6 prs, S 2° W. 8 prs, S 32° W 7 prs, S 2° W 8 prs, S 7° W 3 ¹/₂ prs to a stone set up on the East side of the aforesaid Branch, N 70° W 32 prs to a stone marked "5", S 21° W 89 ⁷/₁₀ prs to the aforesaid stone marked "6" and then S 84° W 4 ⁷/₁₀ prs to the beginning, containing sixtyfour acres and three square perches More or less
