 Letters patent of the United States for "Improvement in
 Linné Kilns" which said letters patent bear date
 the fourteenth day of April in the year Eighteen
 hundred and fifty seven — And whereas Doctor
 Thomas le Ristean of Baltimore County State
 of Maryland is desirous of acquiring an interest
 therein — Now this Indenture Witnesseth that
 for and in Consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars
 Lawful Money to me in hand paid the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged — I have assigned
 sold and set over, and by these presents do hereby
 assign sell and set over unto the said Thomas le
 Ristean. The right to erect and use one Kiln
 on his farm in said County of Baltimore which
 right I have in the said invention as secured to me
 by said letters patent and in no other place or places
 than on his said farm the same to be used by the
 said Thomas le Ristean for his own use and
 behoof and for the use of his legal representatives or
 assigns for the full end and term which said letters
 patents are or may be issued or granted as fully and
 entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed
 by me had this assignment and sale not been made.
