Failure of the Strike on the Trunk Lines.

THE SITUATION IN BALTIMORE.

Resumption on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad—Dispatch of Trains Under Notice of the Federal Government.

(Reported for the Baltimore Sun.)

Business in Baltimore on Saturday felt the impetus of the resumption of traffic on the trunk lines of railroads between the East and the West. Much blocked freight was instantly released. The streets, on which freight cars had been piled up, were cleared of the obstruction, and the usual activity was noticeable in several branches of trade. Thirty-four freight trains were moved between Baltimore and Cumberland since the Baltimore and Ohio railroad. Beyond Cumberland difficulties still existed in West Virginia, which will be moved, it was thought, to-day.

On the Corn and Flour Exchange the immediate effect of the good news was to unsettle dealers in grain for the time being, and the market was temporarily disorganized.
