Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to M<sup>r</sup> John Gibson three Pounds five Shillings for Boat Hire &c. as per Account.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Cap<sup>t</sup> John Haskins Stone forty eight Pounds ten Shillings being the Ballance of his general Account to the 3<sup>d</sup> Instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Major Thomas Price £39.. 3.. 9 for cloathing for the Troops.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Major Price fifteen Pounds four Shillings and three Pence, the Amount of his Account for Subsistence till the 14<sup>th</sup> of March.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to M<sup>r</sup> Isaac Harris all the Musquets now in the Magazine, which are not fitted with Steel Ramrods in Order that they may be fitted therewith.
