Forty Pieces Roles, seventy four Pieces Hessings Forty Five Pieces Oznabrigs and two and half reams Cartridge Paper it being all the paper now in Magazine: I shall render an accot by Capt Fulford of all stores now in the Magazine: The musquets which came in Capt Tibbitt was delivered to Capt Nath Smith agreeable to an order from you, which was all I have had in the Magazine except one received from Major Gist which he bought for the Province, I did not agree with the Skipper Paul Miller for the Freight of the Linnens you'l please to settle with him:

I am y^r mo: Hum¹ Serv^t Gerrard Hopkins son R^d

P. S. Capt Smith has 55 musquets.

Monday 6 May 1776.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Samuel Miller three Pounds Currency for Boat hire.
