Cecilius &c To all the Inhabitants and people of Our said Province Greeting in Our Lord God everlasting Know yee that Wee reposeing especial trust and confidence in the fidelity integrity and circumspection of Our dearly beloved Nephew Baker Brooke Esq^r Our Surveyour Generall of Our said Province of Maryland have assigned Ordained authorized and impowered as Wee doe hereby assigne Ordaine authorize and empower him the said Baker Brooke Once yearely and every yeare to call a Court of Enquiry and Survey in every respective County within this Our Province at such time and in such place in the said severall and respective Countyes as
