

Page 199, line 19. White Hall. On the Severn, near the present Annapolis.

Page 250, line 19. "Toalse." Probably for toll-house or custom-house.

Page 252, line 2. Nanjemy. Now Nanjemoy in Charles County near the Potomac.

Page 276, line 44. Notley Hall. A manor in St. Mary's County on Choptico Creek.

Page 336, line 7. Beaver Dam. In St. Mary's County, north of Britton's Bay.

Page 361, line 9. Transquakin. In Dorchester County.

Page 364, line 27. Britton's Bay. An estuary of the lower Potomac in St. Mary's County.

Page 369, line 30. Point Lookout. The southern point of St. Mary's County.

Page 371, line 14. Calvert's Creek. A creek in St. Mary's County, running into the Potomac.

Page 372, line 27. Nomony Bay. On the Virginia side of the Potomac, opposite Britton's Bay.

Page 416, line 9. Road River. In Anne Arundel County.
