In Council Annapolis 16<sup>th</sup> Ap<sup>l</sup> 1777.

Gentlemen

From your State of the Circumstances of the Insurgents in your Possession, we could wish it was in our Power to save you the Trouble, and the Public the Expence of sending them hither, but they must be sent up ; we imagine it will be the easiest and cheapest way to send them by Water, with a Guard not numerous, but sufficient to take Care of them. Elihu Hall Junior appointed Ensign in the first Company of the first Regiment.

Vachel Burgess appointed Ensign of the eighth Company in the first Regiment.

Ordered, That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to Ebenezer Handy twenty five shillings for a Blanket.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut<sup>t</sup> Edward Duvall four pounds, seven shillings for Blankets for four soldiers in Captain Neal's Company.

That the said Treasurer pay to David Hunter fifteen pounds, five shillings, for Am<sup>t</sup> of Acc<sup>t</sup>
