Garrat Vansweeringen of the City of S^t Maries in S^t Maries County upon oath Examined Declared in the words foll (viz.)

p. 297 At the time when M^r ffrancklyn was sheriff of Anne Arrund^{ll} County, I then stood indebted unto Coll Tailler a considerable summe of Tobacco, and was obleiged by a bond to procure an ord^r for the said Tobacco upon the Sheriff of Anne Arrundell County. And did thereupon supplicate my Lord to pay and satisfie unto Coll Tailler the full quantity of Sixteene thousand pounds of tobacco in the same County. Upon which ord^r I had my bond delivered up, Coll Tailler was well satisfied with the same ord^r but the yeare following or the latter end of that yeare I cannot well tell Coll Tailler told me that the sheriff had not complied with my Lord's ord^r and that he should be forced to stay till another yeare for his Tobacco; My Lord told me also that he had given Coll Tailler an ord^r for the Sixteene thousand pounds of tobacco in Anne Arrundell County which was due to me from his L^{sp}:

The said Coll Tailler p^r his Atto^{ney} proceeds to the prooffe of his acco^t and begins with the 2^d Article, in ord^r whereunto he prayes inspection may be had into his L^{sp}s bookes of Acc^{ts} made up and left by his L^{sp}: in this Province at his de^pture for England, which being accordingly done it appeared by his L^{sp}s Booke N^o 1: that the said Coll Taillor was therein charged with the summe of Sixteene thousand pounds of tobacco ordered him in the hands of M^r Robert ffrancklyn, and hath Credit^t given him by his L^{sp} for the said summe upon the acco^t of M^r Vansweeringen.
