

Lib. R. R. R. up, which being in the precedent yeares acc<sup>t</sup> or ball thereof (as in all probability appeare) the said Burges they conceive not chargeable therew<sup>th</sup> unless he were security and became bound with the s<sup>d</sup> ffrancklyn in his sheriffes bond that yeare also.

W<sup>ch</sup> Coll Taillor being called affirmeth was soe.

But Coll Burges refuses to owne the same and insists upon the prooffe thereof to be made to their Hono<sup>rs</sup>

The Sheriffes bonds for every yeare of ffrancklyns Sheriffaldry were produced p<sup>r</sup> which it appeared that Coll Burges was bound with ffrancklyn in the yeares 1680 & 1681: soe that the first Article of the acc<sup>t</sup> passed and allowed for good

The rem<sup>r</sup> of the acc<sup>t</sup> & the debate thereof left till next Prov<sup>l</sup> Court time according to the following ord<sup>r</sup> (viz:)

By the Councill March 5<sup>th</sup> 1686.

Ordered that the stateing and adjusting the acc<sup>ts</sup> betweene the hon<sup>ble</sup> Coll Thomas Taillor and Coll W<sup>m</sup> Burges by them referred to this board, and the further debate and consideration thereof be referred untill the next Prov<sup>l</sup> Court, and that in the meane time the said Coll Taillor be desired at his leisure to produce his booke of acc<sup>ts</sup> to the hon<sup>ble</sup> Coll W<sup>m</sup> Digges at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Maries for him to inspect and peruse, take coppies and make report to this board of what he shall think necessary for their better Information and light in the business in ord<sup>r</sup> to determine and make their award therein.

The hon<sup>ble</sup> Coll Henry Darnall informes the board that besides his L<sup>sps</sup> generall Lett<sup>rs</sup> to his Councill, he had recd. pticular and especiall commands from his L<sup>spp</sup>: to take all effectuall care imaginable for the Security and safe guard of the ffrontires and heads of the Rivers from any fforreign Invasions or incroachm<sup>ts</sup> to be made upon any part of his L<sup>sps</sup> claime, and more especially had recommended to him the maintenance of the ffort at Xtina bridge, wherefore he prayed the consideration and ord<sup>r</sup> of this board what fitt and necessary to be done therein.
