

Doyle, Wilkie, Steel and Calkerwood, and also the remains of col. Patton's regiment, except capt. M'Lane's company, be incorporated into one regiment, and added to the Pennsylvania line, as an eleventh regiment, and that capt. M'Lane's company be annexed to the Delaware regiment."

COL. THOMAS HARTLEY, COMMISSIONED 1 JANUARY, 1777.

COL. JOHN PATTON, COMMISSIONED 11 JANUARY, 1777.

These were 2 of the Additional 16 Regiments. Hartley's was transferred to the Pennsylvania Line and designated the Eleventh Pennsylvania, the original Eleventh Pennsylvania having been disbanded 1 July, 1778. Patton's was broken up 13 January, 1779, and attached to Hartley's, except capt. McClean's Company, which was attached to the Delaware Line.
