The House of Assembly (pursueant to his Ex^{ncie} the Gouverno^r Order) haveing Adjourned on the 9th day of June in the yeare of our Lord 1692, untill the 20th day of October then next Ensueing, were afterwards by their Maj^{ties} Proclamaçõn from time to time prorogued untill the 13th day of October in the yeare of our Lord 1693: And now by their Maj^{ties} Speciall Sumons beareing date day of August 1693: were Called to meet & appeare at the Citty of S^t Maries the 20th day of September aboue Recited, being Wednesday, where being mett, M^r Speaker with the rest of the members went downe to the State house, where they seuerally in Order tooke their places.
