Vpon Complaint made by Cap<sup>t</sup> Gerrard Slye how Lib. H. D.  
that the Church built at Wiccocomoco for King and  
Queen parish in S<sup>t</sup> Maries County is placed upon  
Land belonging to the s<sup>d</sup> Cap<sup>t</sup> Slye without any Whitehall  
purchase or Satisfaction made for the Same; Or-  
dered that the Vestrymen of the s<sup>d</sup> Parish make Return unto  
his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> in Councill &<sup>ca</sup> how the s<sup>d</sup> Matter is, and that they  
have notice to doe the same by the Sherriff of the s<sup>d</sup> County.

Ordered that the Colonel of each respective  
County give directions to the Cheif Officer of the

fitted and in good Ord<sup>r</sup> ready prepared Severally to  
make Answer to their Names according to the Lists Whitehall  
or Muster Rolls of them taken; against his Ex<sup>ncys</sup>  
coming to see them Exercised, which he intends (God willing)  
vcry shortly.

Ordered that due prosecution be made by M<sup>r</sup>  
Attorney and Sollicito<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>ll</sup> ag<sup>t</sup> all persons that

to the Severall Ord<sup>rs</sup> of Councill hence issued & th<sup>t</sup> Whitehall  
a Copy thereof be delivered to them by the Clerk  
of this Board accordingly.

Ordered that the Sherriff of Prince Georges  
County do upon Sight hereof Summons Coll: Henry  
Darnall so that he be and appear before his Ex<sup>ncy</sup>  
the Gov<sup>r</sup> at the port of Annapolis & bring with him Whitehall  
all Navigacōn Bonds and Certificates remaining in  
his Custody in Ord<sup>r</sup> to deliver up the same before he departs  
the province.

deliver up upon Oath all Navigation Bonds and Certificates  
taken by Coll: Will<sup>m</sup> Steevens in his life time, remaining in  
the possession of the s<sup>d</sup> Esq Layfield the w<sup>ch</sup> (after such Oath Whitehall  
made) are to be lodged with the s<sup>d</sup> Coll. Hutchins, a due  
Return whereof is to be made unto his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> at the Port of  
Annapolis with all Convenient Speed.
