M^r Williams from the House of Delegates deliver to the Governor the following Resolve

By the House of Delegates April 9th 1778.

Resolved That the Governor and the Council be empowered and requested during this Session of Assembly to appoint and Commission Militia Officers for Cecil, Harford, and Caroline Counties or any other County where it may be Judged necessary By order G Duvall Cl H. D. Thus endorsed, By the Senate April 9th 1778 Read and Assented to By order R Ridgely Cl. Sen.

Certificate given to Col Birkhead that it appears necessary that he shall draw on the Eastern shore Treasurer for four Pounds, fourteen Shillings and six Pence as per Account of William Maynadier and for Six Pounds five Shillings as per Certificate of John Bracco, Register of the Orphans Court on Account of William Brinsfield a wounded Soldier in the first Class of the 4th Batt of Talbot County.
