That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Richard Jones a 9 months Soldier in the 3^d Maryland Regiment discharged, the amount of Thirteen Pounds Fifteen shillings and six Pence in Cloathing being the balance due him by Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army
