Which said Order was Sign'd as well by his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> the Gov<sup>r</sup> the Members of her Majestys hon<sup>ble</sup> Councill as by the Speaker of the house of Delegates on the behalf & in the Name of the whole house.

Came Coll John Contee & brought the Severall Addresses to her Majesty & the Lord high Treasurer from the house & p. 468 acquainted his Ex<sup>ncy</sup> that the house had nothing before them

His Ex<sup>ncy</sup> acquaints him that he waits their coming up to the Councill Chamber.
