Great Britain &<sup>ca</sup> I will this be a Law.

that with Advice of her Majesty's Hoñble Council he thought  
fit to prorogue this present General Assembly until the 29<sup>th</sup>  
Day of November Instant.

Thereupon M<sup>r</sup> Speaker and the Members returned to their  
own House and prorogued themselves accordingly.

So ended this present fourth Session of Assembly on the  
3<sup>d</sup> Day of November 1711
