 P. C. R. gentⁿ & Rob^t Clearke gentⁿ ffeoffees in trust; for & in the behalfe of
 the s^d Jane, Three negro seruants (Viz) Two negro men, & One
 negro woman, to say, William Allington & Tom: Payne: & Nan: &
 all their issue both male & ffemale, Six Milch Cowes & Three heyfers
 wth their encrease, Two yowng Mares, & a Stone horse, wth their
 encrease. One halfe of the howshould goods, that shall bee in the
 possesⁿ of the s^d Cuthbert att the hower of his Death, wth all the
 wearing cloaths, ringes & Jewells of the s^d Jane, To haue & to hold
 p. 219 the sayd Recyted premises & euery part thereof unto her the s^d Jane,
 & the heyres lawfully begotten betweene mee the s^d Cuthbert ffen-
 wick, and shee the s^d Jane, whither male or ffemale (or both) to bee
 equally deuided after her Decease, Prouided allwayes th^t the same &
 euery part thereof graunted as afores^d, shall bee & remaine to the
 only use, benefitt & behoofe of mee the s^d Cuthbert during my Natur-
 all life, And in case I the s^d Cuthbert shall happen to depart this
 life wthout issue betweene mee the s^d Cuthbert & shee the s^d Jane as
 afores^d, That then the s^d demised premises & euery part thereof, wth
 the proceed, profitt, & increase thereof shall bee & remaine to the
 only use, benefitt, & behoofe of the s^d Jane her heyres, Executo^{rs}, or
 Adm̄istrato^{rs}, And for the true & reall p^eformance of this Deed &
 euery part & parcell thereof, in manner & forme afores^d I the s^d
 Cuthbert ffenwick doe bind ou^e unto the s^d Will^m Eltonhead gentⁿ &
 Rob^t Clearke gentⁿ. The sayd Three Negros, & Three other Negros:
 the s^d six Cowes, & other Six Cowes, The s^d Three heyfers & other
 Three heyfers, The s^d Two mares & other Two mares: The s^d
 Stone horse, & one other Stone-horse, To bee all lyable & responsible
 for the full assurance of making good the afores^d Joynture for the
 use of the s^d Jane, her heyres Executo^{rs} or Adm̄istrato^{rs} as afores^d.

It. All the Rest I doe desyre should be deuided equally amongst
 the Children that is to say Cuthbert ffenwick, Ignatius, Robert,
