That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Thomas Mason five pounds July 28 five shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as Liber C. B. aforesaid due him for Stores to the 31st Inst. p Acct passed by the p. 116 Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Edward Prall fourteen pounds five shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for Stores per Account passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^o Thomas Jones seventeen pounds ten Shillings of the Money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Account passed by the Aud. Gen¹

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct^r Charles Frederick Wiesenthall one thousand five hundred and forty three pounds six shillings and nine pence Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State p Acc^t passed by the Aud. G¹

An Order of the 5th of May 1781 in favor of Doct^r Wiesenthall for four thousand five hundred and Sixty seven pounds, two shillings and nine pence is returned and the Auditor General directed to give Credit for the same.

Ordered that the Issuing Commissary deliver to Capt Richard Waters of the 3^d Regim^t thirty two Gallons of Rum and one hundred and twenty eight pounds of sugar. Capt. Thomas Mason four Gallons of Rum and sixteen pounds of Sugar. Capt. Edward Prall of the 1 Regim^t Ten Gallons of Rum and forty pounds of sugar. and also to Col^o Thomas Jones two days rations for himself and 18 hands employed in bringing Recruits from Dorchester County.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt. John Sprigg Belt of the 1st Regimt facings for a Coat.

That the Armourer deliver to Col^o Jones one hundred Musket Cartridges for the use of the Dorchester Militia.

Commission issued to John Stevens appointed Sheriff of Dorchester County in the room of James Woolford resigned.

We think it necessary the Flour collected in the several Counties p. 223 on the western shore should be turned over to the proper continental Officers at such Posts assigned by the Commander in Chief for depositing it as you may think most convenient attending to the respective quantities directed to be lodged at each Post on this Shore. Our Order to the Commissary of St Mary's County directing him to procure and forward one hundred Head of Cattle to George Town for the use of the Militia there assembled there was not countermanded, owing to Hurry and the Multiplicity of Business always before this Board. We would have them turned over to the continental officer there as soon as possible.
