p. 325 M^r Steward informs us that he has directed his Son to deliver over to you, the five thousand Dollars, brought in by Capt. Martin, for the State. Upon your receiving the Money, you will be pleased, if you have delivered our former Letter to the Naval Officer, to deliver the enclosed also, which countermands the Orders contained in the other; you will also deliver the Letter to the Attorney General. We have put you to much Trouble in this Business, but we have been induced thereto by our Opinion of your Desire to render the Public any real Service, which we hope will be our Apology.
