That the Said Treasurer pay to Capt John Courts Jones nineteen pounds, eighteen Shillings of the same Emission per Acc^t passed.—

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Denny three pounds seven shillings and six pence specie for the use of Major John Lynch per Account passed.—
