But to shew how averse I am to have the public Debt increased, without a Prospect of advantaging our Country, and how uneasy I am at the Thoughts of detaining you against your Inclinations, I have, with the Advice of his Lordship's Council of State, thought fit to prorogue this Assembly to Wednesday the First Day of May next; and you are to take Notice you are prorogued to that Day accordingly.

Thus endeth this Session of Assembly, this 9th Day of March, Anno Domini 1754.
