

Liber C D Charles &c.<sup>a</sup> To the Sheriff of Calvert County Greeting Whereas one John Newton mariner his Certain Bond or writeing obligatory under his hand & Seal bearing date the 27.<sup>th</sup> day of march 1676 became bound to us in the penall Summe of one hundred thousand p.<sup>ds</sup> of Tob.<sup>o</sup> w<sup>th</sup> Condiçion there under written for paym.<sup>t</sup> unto us of the Summe of forty nine thousand ninety Six pounds of Tob.<sup>o</sup> upon demand & Whereas we have by our Attorney Gen.<sup>ll</sup> Comēnced an açon in our provinciall Co.<sup>rt</sup> ag.<sup>t</sup> the Said Newton for Recovering the s.<sup>d</sup> debt of one hundred thousand p.<sup>ds</sup> of Tob.<sup>o</sup> w.<sup>ch</sup> the s.<sup>d</sup> Jn.<sup>o</sup> Newton hath not p.<sup>d</sup> or Satisfied though the ten Re-quired And Whereas y<sup>e</sup> Said Jn<sup>o</sup> Newton is upon departure out of this province & may depart before he hath answered the Said action as afores.<sup>d</sup> brought & thereby no Redress or Relief can be had for us These are therefore to require you that you take the Body of him the Said John Newton if found within your Bailiwick and him Safe keep till he hath Entered into Recognizance with Sufficient Suretys to our S<sup>d</sup> Co.<sup>rt</sup> to pay to us the s.<sup>d</sup> debt of one hundred thousand pounds of Tob.<sup>o</sup> with Costs of Suit if he Shall be Cast in the Said Suit & to do & pform what our s.<sup>d</sup> Co.<sup>rt</sup> Shall do & determine y<sup>fein</sup> & hereof &c Wittness our Self &c 19<sup>th</sup> Apr 1<sup>t</sup> 22 may
