Ordered that M.^r Johnson M.^r F. Gantt M.^r Hollyday M.^r Key M.^r R. Goldsborough M.^r John Hall M.^r Deye M.^r Smallwood M.^r Wolstenholme M.^r Hammond & M.^r Smith do prepare and bring in the same accordingly

On Motion of Col.^o Tilghman Leave is given to bring in a Bill Entituled a Supplementary Act to the Act relating to the Standard of English Weights and Measures

Ordered that Col.^o Tilghman M.^r Chase and M.^r Hollyday do prepare and bring in the same

On Motion of Col.^o Tilghman that a Committee be appointed to draw a Remonstrance to his Excellency the Governor
