

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Clark Seven hundred and sixty eight pounds, nineteen shillings, and three pence three farthings Current Money due for Expenditures in repairing the public buildings, up to the 22d. of July per Account examined by the Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Aquila Paca for the use of Margaret Kemble Administratrix of Stephen, Ten pounds, five shillings Current Money Balance of 5 Months pay due him as a Soldier of the 3d. Regiment from 1st. of August 1780 to 1st. of January 1781 per Certificate of Auditor General.
