That the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Ann Levascher widow of the late Lieut. John Levascher, Fifteen pounds for three months half pay allowed her in Virtue of An Act of the General Assembly, ending the 8th. Instant.

That the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Mary Hilleary widow of the late Lieut. Rignal Hilleary Fifteen pounds for three Months half pay allowed her in Virtue of An Act of Assembly, due the 8th. instant.

The Council adjourned 'till tomorrow morning 11 o'clock.
