Tuesday 15th. June 1790

The Bond delivered by Mr. Fowler to the Treasurer.

Indulgence granted to Arthur Alexander and James Milligan of Cæcil County agreeably to the Act respecting the Debtors and Creditors of this State &ca, they having transmitted their writing of Consent properly attested to accept the indulgence offered by the said Act, which is ordered to be delivered to the Treasurer aforesaid—Writing of Consent delivered to the Treasurer by the Clerk.
