It being represented by the Chief Justice of the second District and the Associate Justices of Queen Anns County, that Margaret Bateman was presented by the Grand Inquest for Queen Anns County for keeping an Ordinary three weeks, without Licence, and was fined for the offence the proportionable quantity of seven hundred and [p. 89] fifty weight of Tobacco agreeably to Act of Assembly, That she appears to the said Justices to have transgressed innocently, that she is reputed to be an honest industrious widow woman, in extreme indigent circumstances, and that she has for several years maintained by her own exertions, a family of six small Children, who are yet able to render her scarcely any assistance. They therefore recommend a remission of the said fine. The Board being satisfied that the facts stated are true, do order and direct that the said fine be remitted upon all costs arising on the said Presentment being paid.
