Such Inspections only excepted, as are particularly Noted in the foregoing List. For the particular Exceptions above Noted, see §. 37 and 129, of this Act. And for all other Attendance of Inspectors, see below, Art. 13.

3. All Tobacco brought to any of the Public Warehouses before-mentioned, shall be viewed, examined and inspected, by Inspectors who shall be thereunto nominated and appointed in Manner following, viz. The Vestry-men and Churchwardens of the several Parishes wherein any Warehouse is established by this Act, shall meet
