The Debt styled vizt

Sommesett the Leonard Jones late of Calvert Island in the province  
of Maryland was obligated to answer unto John Wallop  
in a plea of Debt

And whereupon the said John Wallop hath by his attorney  
Allington Draper hath by the said Leonard Jones did upon  
the second day of August Annoy Domini 1673 by a certain  
specialty signed with the hand and sealed with the seal  
of him the said Leonard Jones (w<sup>ch</sup>: is produced here in  
Co<sup>rt</sup>) affirm upon himselfe and promise that he the said  
Jones would pay a sume to be paid unto John Wallop of  
St. Maries County in the province of Maryland one thousand  
three hundred sixty and five pounds of Maryland  
leaf tobacco to be paid to John Wallop or to his attorney  
attorney hereunto: adu<sup>er</sup> or assignee upon demand  
after the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October next ensuing the date of the  
S<sup>d</sup>: specialty within the precincts of St. Georges Hundred  
in the County of St. Maries to be performed of  
which the said Richard Kinge Esq<sup>r</sup>: his chief executor and  
administrator
