This Com^{ee} taking the premises into their serious consideration doth ordene that John Chancier and Abigail Harrington pay unto Richard Jenison or his order two hundred pounds of Tobacco apiece for satisfaction for his trouble and charge.

Whereas Abigail Harrington was presented by the grand Enquest for bearing a bastard child she appears before the board & acknowledge her selfe guilty & saith the master of y^e child is John Chanceller who appears before the board & owns the same whereupon this Com^{ee} ordene that y^e said John Chanceller & Abigail Harrington have twenty shillings apiece well paid on upon the bare back; wh^{ch} was executed accordingly.

Whereas George Holland was presented by the grand Enquest for bearing a bastard child of W^m Greene w^t never spake after; M^r Richard Williams & Richard Brittain were examined upon oath on the behalfe of the Lord Prop^{er} & nothing was made appear, This Com^{ee} ordene that abijah be the next County Com^{ee} & y^e W^m Greene be summoned to y^e next County before the Lord Prop^{er}.

Whereas Thonias Pool recovered by way of attachment agt. John Body the summe of one thousand poundes of Tobacco the same being attaried in the hands of m^r W^m Stevens of this County gent^{le} The said Thonias Pool doth here in Com^{ee} acknowledge to have rec^d of m^r W^m Stevens the said one thousand poundes of Tobacco attaried in the hands of John Body.

Whereas severall persons are concerned as parties or servitors for work towards making a bridge over the devideing Creek. It is ordered that all persons concerned be summoned to appear before Com^{ee} to shew cause why not done or else to pay so much Tobacco to such persons to performe it.

Whereas m^r George Johnson was presented by the grand Enquest for selling gunpowder to y^e Indians & y^e Indians: Thonias Scarbeck: Ab^m Gullet & Ambrose Gordon being examined upon oath on the behalfe of the Lord Prop^{er} did the Com^{ee} finding nothing of Proove from the evidencee thereof said George Johnson was discharged by Proclamation.

Whereas m^r Edw^m Smith was presented by the grand Enquest for selling of powder & shot to the Indians: The said Edward Smith being upon his Oath & no evidence appearing to make good the charge: was discharged by Proclamation.
