

Underscriven doe acknowledge to have rec<sup>d</sup> sold unto Allexander Lemison one man servant by name John Manser & doe assigne over all my right and Title in the said servant for the term of four years beginning the tenth day of October 1672 as witness my hand & seal 30<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1672

Signed Seal & delivered in the presence of us Testes Edward Davis Jobell Taylor

Edward Davis maketh oath in C<sup>o</sup> by the same Jarvis Ballard signe Seal & deliver the said writing ; / ;

This C<sup>o</sup> taking the Premises into their serious Consideration doe order by John Manser and Abigail Harvingdon pay unto Richard Kembell or his order two hundred pounds of Tobacco apiece for satisfaction for his trouble and charge

Whereas Abigail Harvingdon was presented by the Grand Enquest for bearing a bastard Child she appears before the board & acknowledgeth her selfe guilty & saith the father of y<sup>e</sup> Child is John Manser who appears before the board & owns the same whereupon this C<sup>o</sup> orders that y<sup>e</sup> said John Manser & Abigail Harvingdon have twenty fifties apiece well laid on upon the bare bark; w<sup>ch</sup> was executed accordingly

Whereas George Holland was presented by the grand Enquest for beating a servant maid of w<sup>m</sup> Greene w<sup>ch</sup> never spake after; Mirzaell Williams & Richard Brittain were examined upon oath on the behalf of the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> & nothing was made appear; This C<sup>o</sup> orders that Mirzaell be the next County C<sup>o</sup> & y<sup>e</sup> w<sup>m</sup> Greene be summoned to y<sup>e</sup> next C<sup>o</sup> on y<sup>e</sup> behalf of y<sup>e</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup>

Whereas Thomas Pool recovered by way of Attachment ag<sup>t</sup> John Body the summe of one thousand pounds of Tobacco the same being attached in the hands of m<sup>r</sup> w<sup>m</sup> Stevens of y<sup>e</sup> County gent<sup>l</sup> The said Thomas Pool doth here in C<sup>o</sup> Acknowledge to have rec<sup>d</sup> of m<sup>r</sup> w<sup>m</sup> Stevens the said one thousand pounds of Tobacco attached in his hands of John Body

Ordered that Agniti (in the Custody of w<sup>m</sup> Keene) being the daughter of w<sup>m</sup> Davis late of Virginia hundred in this County be brought before his Ex<sup>ty</sup> Justices the next County C<sup>o</sup>

Whereas severall persons are concerned as parties or security for work towards making a bridge over the river of the said County. It is ordered that all persons concerned be summoned to appear next C<sup>o</sup> to shew cause why not done or else to pay soe much Tobacco to the persons to performe it

Whereas m<sup>r</sup> George Johnson was presented by the grand Enquest for selling ammunition to y<sup>e</sup> Indians w<sup>m</sup> Hamer: Thomas Seawell: Ab<sup>m</sup> Gullet & Ambrose London being examined upon oath on the behalf of y<sup>e</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> And the C<sup>o</sup> finding nothing of Proof from the Evidence the said George Johnson was discharged by Proclamacion

Whereas m<sup>r</sup> Edw<sup>d</sup> Smith was presented by the Grand Enquest for selling of powder & shot to the Indians: The said Edward Smith being upon his Oath & no Evidence appearing to make good the charge: was discharged by Proclamacion
