"Provided, that nothing in this Act contained shall be construed to exempt from taxation any of the property or franchises of the consolidated company, or of any of the constituent companies, or to confer upon the consolidated company, or upon any of the constituent companies, any rights, privileges or immunities, inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of this State."
