AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Insert before section 3 the following:

"Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, that section 3, of chapter 704, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the session of 1892, entitled 'An Act to provide for the assessment and collection of a tax upon distilled spirits,' be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted, and that an additional section be added to said chapter 104, to be known as 'Section 12,' said sections 3 and 12 to read as follows:"
