

1 I know that in Montgomery County, rich as it
2 is, there are many unequal education opportunities; and
3 I think that the 5,000 families in Montgomery County who
4 live below the poverty level know what unequal opportunity
5 for education is; when no special teacher reaches the corners
6 of our counties, when the classes are larger, when the
7 facilities are poorer, when the libraries don't have books,
8 this is unequal educational opportunity, and I don't think
9 that the State of Maryland has to continue to promote or
10 to foster, if you will, or to encourage unequal educational
11 opportunity.

12 I don't think, and I know it is bothering the
13 delegates, you have the specter of New York in front of
14 you. You don't want to make a constitution that the papers
15 will say is going to cost billions of dollars. I agree
16 with you, but I do think that you can set a policy for this
17 day that no children suffer because another child gets
18 more.

19 I don't think that this means what you are
20 attempting to read into it. It does not mean locked in
21 education, but it does mean that we would go at it in
