3 ment has been made by Delegate Johnson that the dictionary
4 definition of "promote" is to help bring to being. I
5 think that is precisely what this is; but I don't think that
6 equates to the same as being provided by law.

9 DELEGATE GLEASON: The delegates may recall
10 during World War II or after World War II, the G.I. Bill
11 of Rights for education for veterans was fostered, and it
12 is that type of thing, all veterans were able to take ad-
13 vantage of its provisions. I went to school under that
14 program.
