2 To me it still says the same thing, and certainly
3 this was the intent of the committee, not to make any
4 change whatever.

5 DELEGATE JAMES: Are there any further questions?

6 Delegate Winslow.

7 DELEGATE WINSLOW: Mr. Chairman, the other day when
8 this matter came up in another report I raised the
9 question about the suspension of the meeting of the Assembly
10 in Annapolis. It seems to me, sir, this has not yet been
11 taken care of, because in response to a question of mine a
12 few minutes ago you answered that only the General Assembly
13 could take action in case of an emergency.

14 Now, suppose in an emergency in Annapolis there
15 is a tidal wave and the legislature can't get to Annapolis.
16 How can it act, because it is not, by the Constitution
17 allowed to act in any place except Annapolis, and it can't
18 get to Annapolis in order to decide to meet some place else?

19 Is there any clarification for that?

20 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: There is not in this as we
21 returned it to the floor.
