4 Mr. President, ladies and gentlemen of this
5 Convention, I am not ashamed of the actions of this new

10 DELEGATE JETT: Mr. President, fellow members
11 of the Convention, I feel that I must speak in favor of
12 unicameralism because I think it is the vehicle that we
13 must use to go forward into the future. It seems to me
14 that we have to deal with the situation that exists today
15 whether we like it or not we have the one-man, one-vote
16 concept with us.

17 I do not think there is a man or woman in this
18 group that does not realize the one branch of this government
19 that needs strengthening, upholding and upbuilding is the
20 Legislative Branch. The image of the legislator in the
