2 form, realistic form of representation, and not this token  
3 representation which would be represented by an 80 member  
4 House of Delegates.

5 I say to you in all sincerity that they make a  
6 real contribution. We penalize them as a State, for example,  
7 by acquiring a very great disproportion, by a dispropor-  
8 tionate number of, for example, State forests, as are re-  
9 plete in Garrett County. We have a superabundance of  
10 Bay bridges proposed so we can get to the Eastern Counties,  
11 but we don't live there. We only enjoy what these people  
12 provide.

13 It is now suggested that they should have what  
14 is best a token representation, and, ladies and gentlemen,  
15 I say this is unfair. It is almost unbelievable to think  
16 that we would reduce this to a situation where we have a  
17 name and hopefully part of a warm body to represent a large  
18 portion of our population.
