

1 hall, and 43 across the way, and all of them are powerful
2 influences throughout the State. When you say that by
3 this Constitution to be adopted in May that you 142 members
4 of the legislature have got to go out and sell this Consti-
5 tution to these people, and they know that 62 of their
6 number are going out and they know not who is going, I will
7 venture to say that you will not get 50 percent of them
8 to go out for this Constitution.

9 The same way with the senators across the
10 hall. Both bodies will be in a hopeless state of confu-
11 sion, not knowing what the future holds for the State legis-
12 lature.

13 So I say you are playing with dynamite to cut
14 it down. If you want to defeat the Constitution, this is
15 one of the ways to do it.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any other delegate who
17 desires to speak in opposition to the amendment?

18 Delegate Hanson.

19 DELEGATE HANSON: Mr. Chairman, I think it
20 might be useful in this debate to inject a historical
21 note about the science by which the numbers 43 and 142
