

1 The proponents of the single-delegate district proposal  
2 urge that this would encourage the election of minority  
3 delegates, ethnic and political. But if we permit this  
4 amendment, if we pass this amendment, we could have people  
5 who don't live in the senate district, but live in the  
6 counties coming to Baltimore City and running.

7 The question is not whether or not they would  
8 be elected, but it certainly would do violence to this  
9 concept of single-member districts.

10 I will vote against the amendment.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Does any other delegate desire to  
12 speak in favor of the amendment?

13 Does any delegate desire to speak in opposition  
14 to the amendment?

15 Are we ready for the question?

16 The question arises on the adoption of  
17 Amendment NO. 15, a vote Yes is a vote in favor  
18 of the amendment, a vote No, a vote against.

20 Has every delegate voted? Does any delegate
