

1 Mr. Chairman: It has been said before that Amendment No. 2
2 is an amendment to amend Amendment No. 1.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: It is not. The Chair incorrectly
4 stated it was an amendment to the amendment. It is a
5 perfecting amendment to Section 1 of the Committee Recom-
6 mendation, and as such may be considered before we consider
7 Amendment No. 1, which would delete the entire section.
8 Delegate Macdonald.

9 DELEGATE MACDONALD: My question is, Mr. Chair-
10 man, why isn't the question on Amendment No. 1?

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Because Amendment No. 2 is a
12 perfecting amendment. It is in order to perfect Section
13 No. 1 before you act on the amendment to delete it so that
14 there will be a clear choice for the Committee of the Whole
15 between deleting the section and retaining it as perfected.

16 Is there any further parliamentary inquiry?
17 Delegate Anderson.

18 DELEGATE ANDERSON: As I see it, if we strike out
19 those words, then there is no reserve of power left,
20 except those things that are mentioned in Paragraph 2.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: That is correct, and I understand
