2 has no authority to do anything about it.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Weidemeyer.

4 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: They could, could they
5 not, at the next general session?

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

7 DELEGATE MORGAN: Delegate Weidemeyer, the
8 Constitution says at the next general session, provided
9 it is not a new General Assembly.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Weidemeyer.

11 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: It would seem to me that
12 in order to be fair to all people of all the state and all
13 the members of the General Assembly that we should not
14 confine it just alone to the special session, which is
15 left to the whim of governor who has vetoed the bill or
16 the leadership of the house.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Weidemeyer, I have sent
18 for a copy of LB-1. My recollection is there is a
19 provision there also for convening a special session
20 by three-fifths of the members; is that correct?
