

1 the General Assembly for the first two years. Am I correct  
2 so far?

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Maurer.

4 DELEGATE MAURER: That is my text.

5 It does not change the technique which has been  
6 adopted by the Committee in how the Governor would handle  
7 reorganization plans. It merely eliminates the two-year  
8 hiatus in which only the General Assembly could initiate  
9 reorganization plans.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Marion.

11 DELEGATE MARION: Delegate Maurer, is it further  
12 correct, then, that the General Assembly even under your  
13 amendment during the first two years would have the authority  
14 to move ahead as it saw fit and enact appropriate legislation  
15 in this regard and during this time the legislature could  
16 check any proposal submitted to it by the Majority vote of  
17 either house if it did not like any proposal advanced by the  
18 Governor during that two-year time?

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Maurer.

20 DELEGATE MAURER: This is entirely correct.
